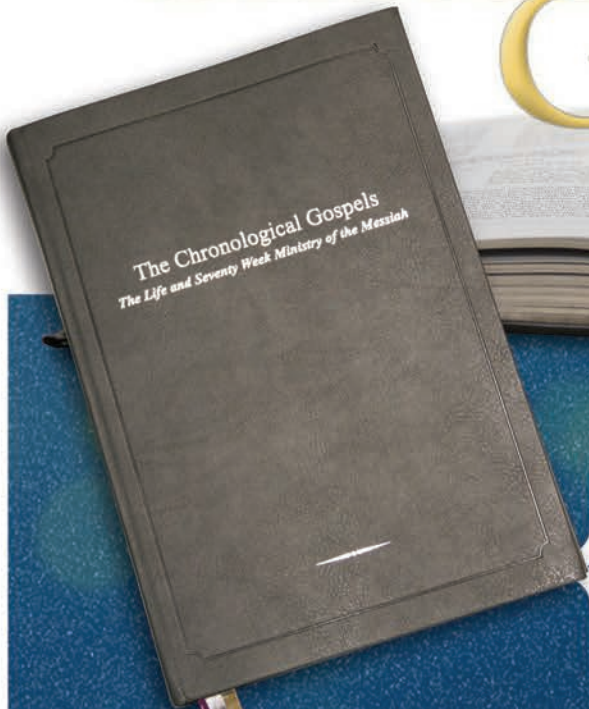

Yeshua had exactly seventy weeks to fulfill his mission, and it had to be accomplished in the rare year that would allow him to prophetically fulfill Pesach (Passover) and the Bikkurim (Firstfruits offering) within the restrictive time parameters of Jonah's prophetic code. Yeshua proclaimed that there would be one sign, and only one sign, of his authenticity – the sign of the prophet Jonah: three days and three nights in the grave and raised on the third day (Matthew 12:38-40). Even though the sign of the prophet Jonah was the one and only sign that Yeshua said would verify his authority...

Why the need for The Chronological Gospels:

Jesus (Yeshua) lived and taught in Israel during the first century - a very different time and place than we find ourselves now. His message, however, is just as important today as it was then. But how much of his message can we truly comprehend from a distance of almost 2,000 years and half a world away? The answer: plenty! But, first we have to understand the cultural and historical perspective of the time and place, and we need to see his actions as they took place - chronologically.

The Chronological Gospels reorganizes Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, The Acts and The Revelation in chronological order. You can see what the Messiah was doing each day of his ministry. You can follow along the timeline of his sermons, his miracles and the last days, hours and moments before his crucifixion. The Chronological Gospels also explains the religious debates and issues at the forefront during the Messiah's ministry and really reveals why he was so hated by those that wanted to kill him.

When reconstructed in this manner, the Gospel records synchronize beautifully. Any apparent contradictions that have bothered you are resolved, and the Messiah's message to his disciples then - and what we can take away from it now - becomes clear and that much more powerful.

No longer do you have to try to piece together the Messiah's life from four separate accounts from different authors with different perspectives. It is done for you! Now all sides of the story are combined and organized so you can watch the motion picture of the Messiah's ministry unfold before your eyes like you've never been able to experience before. If you have ever longed to truly know your Messiah, this is what you have been awaiting.
